This Skills Camp will be unique in nature as it will take place on Georgian Bay behind
the Bobby Orr Hall of Fame.

Each player will receive two sessions on ice and one session off ice.

Lunch will be provided for the players as well as a light snack.

Parents are encouraged to attend and watch the day's activities.

We suggest that you bring a folding chair to make yourself more comfortable.

We ask that players bring a shovel to help scrape the ice at the end of each session.

Although goaltenders are not required, they welcome to attend in players gear.

In the event that the weather is extremely cold that day, players will only be required to
wear their helmets, gloves, neck protector and mouth guard. Full equipment will not be
required.

A determination will be made the day of the event.

Please come dressed in your gear, with snow pants ready to go if needed.

Skates can be put on at the rink and brought into the Hall of Fame after to warm up.

Please make sure if you bring your skates into the Hall of Fame to warm up; you have
skate guards on them.
